## Summer Outings



**May 12** – Sunriver Park – We will meet at the park at 10:00 am. The playground is new and there is a sandbox area and tons of grass, but no bathrooms! The church is about a two minute drive if there is a potty emergency. If your first name starts with A-K please bring a pastry/muffin item to share. If your name starts with L-Z please bring juice to share. Napkins and cups will be provided. See you there!

**May 19** – The Fountains – It offers an interactive water feature, playground, train rides, food and shopping. Train rides are FREE on Thursdays! Meet by the water fountain at 10 am.

**May 26** – Livermore Community Park -- This park has a "waterfall" and "creek" for children to play in. You may want to pack a toy for your child to send down the creek. There is also a playground and beach volleyball courts. You know the drill: 10 am, A-K: snack food, L-Z: drinks.

**June 2** – Rancho Cordova Fire Department – Station 65, 11201 Colomo, Rancho Cordova - 10 am.

**June 9** – Stone Creek Community Park – This is a great park! They have a water play area, so dress your kids appropriately. There is also a playground, sandbox, covered tables, and a huge grassy area (bring dogs or kites)! If your first name starts with A-K please bring a pastry/muffin item to share. If your name starts with L-Z please bring juice to share. Napkins and cups will be provided. We will be there at 10:00a m.

**June 16** – Farm and Swim Day – Our own Becky's parents own and operate Davis Farm. We will meet at the farm at 10 am. They will have wagon rides out to their produce farm. The kids will be able to see how all the different fruits and vegetables grow and possibly pick some! We will then head to the Davis' house for swimming and a picnic lunch. Everyone bring your own sack lunch. The Davis house also has goats, chickens, and a pond where kids can feed and catch fish (bring your own pole)!

**June 23** – Hagan Community Park – A huge park with playground, dog park, ducks, barn, and access to the river. There is a \$4 parking fee to park inside the park. Free parking is available just outside the park or at the end of Ambassador Dr. We will meet at the playground by the dog park. 10 am, A-K: snack, L-Z: drinks.

**June 30** – Effie Yeaw Nature Center – A cultural and environmental center. It offers rescued wild animals (they had 4 snakes and two owls when we went), a discovery room, a replica Maidu Indian summer village, and several nature trails (with the possibility of seeing a variety of wild animals). Meet in the "Maidu Indian village" at 10 am.

**July 7** – Bridgeway Lake Community Park – This is another spray ground park; fully equipped with water guns, dumping cones, and spray log. It sits next to a man-made lake and has all of the typical park features. We'll meet at 10 am! Bring your snack item!

**July 14** – VBS – Mom2Mom goes to New York this summer! We wish, but a week of child free mornings is nice too!

**July 21** – Folsom's Kid Play Park – Not too many wood playgrounds around anymore. This wood playground has a castle design, toddler area, sandbox, and tire swing! As always meet at 10 am with your snack item to share.

**July 28** – "Be the Change" – Our kids are going to raise money and purchase school supplies for needy children. They will raise money by asking family and friends to sponsor them in a jog-a-thon/bike-a-thon. Thursday at 10 am we will jog/bike around Sunriver Park. Then they will collect their money, shop for school supplies, and return them to the church office by August 5.

**August 4** – Southside Park – A big hit with the kids last year (and moms too). A favorite feature - the carousel! The playground is interactive, there is a toddler area, and the ever popular sandbox. 10 am, A-K: snack food, L-Z: drinks.

**August 11** – Sunriver Park – This will kick off the 2011/2012 Mom2Mom season! Bring every mom you can think of who would benefit from the love and laughter we absorb every Thursday. Meet at 10:00 am with snacks in hand!
